Simon Moreau

He studied film and visual effects before coming to Berlin. There, the local circus scene gave him the inspiration to turn his hobby into a profession.

Since then he has been training corporal mime, clowning and juggling with different teachers. In 2022, he studied at the clown school "Le Samovar" in Paris,

In 2018 he put together the street show "L'Escale" and has been touring with it in Europe's cities and festivals (Vevey, Lenzburg, Aurillac) for the last three years.

Marc Zeun

Since 2012 he performed, mainly in the clownesque juggling duo "Die Freudenbergs", but also showed solo pieces on festivals, stages and streets all over the world (Europe, USA, Central America, Asia, Australia).

He has a completed circus pedagogical training and since 2017 he is a permanent part of the children and youth circus "Zirkomania" in Leipzig.

From 2018 he began not only juggling on stage but hosted cabaret shows, open stages and gala shows at various festivals.
